Reduce the complexity in working with airfreight partners


Destination agents/consignees can open an account in WIN free of charge to get the following capabilities:

- ▶ Log-in to the WIN web or on mobile to see all their shipments with WIN partners
- ▶ Log-in to in their own system to see all their shipments with WIN partners (Integration required - No charge to integrate)
- ▶ Access full AWB details sent by the origin partner
- ▶ Get full tracking statuses and alerts of AWBs on web, email and mobile
- ▶ Print AWBs
- ▶ Access to pouch documents
- ▶ AWB information in JSON/XML formats

These capabilities allow destination agents to get started on their end of the process sooner, well before airline notification of shipment arrival and can even help facilitate e-freight or e-AWB adoption using e-pouch documents.
